

## **Cambrian College students enrolling at Laurentian University Application/Registration process**

1. Cambrian College students should apply to the Ontario University Application Centre (OUAC) while registered in their graduating year at Cambrian College. Students can apply on line at [www.ouac.on.ca](http://www.ouac.on.ca).
2. Once students start entering their Undergraduate Application on line and report their prior academic achievements, a drop down box will appear asking if the applicant would like to request a transcript. Students can request their Cambrian College transcript or a transcript from any other Ontario institution at this point.
3. Students should also request through OUAC that a copy of their graduating transcript be forwarded Laurentian University.
4. Once Laurentian University receives notice of the application from OUAC they review it to grant conditional acceptance. This conditional acceptance will be removed when the student's final graduating transcript is sent to Laurentian University.
5. Upon receipt of the student's final transcript, Laurentian University will review the terms of the articulation agreement to grant final acceptance.
6. The student must acknowledge the acceptance offer from Laurentian University indicating that they will be attending.
7. The student will receive a registration package that they must complete to register and pay their fees.

### Note:

Applicants to the Bachelor of Arts in Communication Studies should make an appointment with Communication program coordinator at Huntington University for assistance in course selection.

Applicants to the Bachelor of Fine Arts should make an appointment with the Fine Arts program coordinator at Thorneloe University for assistance in course selection.
