Minimum GPA requirement for admission is 2.5. Admission to this program is highly competitive and the annual admission average is generally considerably higher than the minimum. In addition, admission and placement in program are determined on the basis of a performance audition.

Years/Credits to Obtain Degree

2 – 3 years depending on placement in the program.

Costs (e.g., tuition, books, etc.)

Tuition at Memorial is \$85 / credit hour. The normal full-time load for students in the School of Music is 17 credits per semester, at a total tuition cost of \$1445 per semester. Students should budget up to \$500 annually for books and supplies. For details see,
