### **Requirements for Admission** (GPA, diploma, testing, etc.)

Students applying for admissions to the university programs are required to provide original documentation showing their full post secondary academic history along with graduation with a relevant certificate and/or diploma from a recognized program and institution. Program of requirements are subject to change. The current program requirements are set out below.

#### **Bachelor of General Studies**

*(120 credits total. A GPA of 2.0 or higher is required for graduation)*

- 45 upper-level credits, 15 of which can be applied credits
- 6 credits in English
- 69 elective credits – lower – or upper-level, 60 of which can be applied credits

*Note: Residency for this program is 15 credits. The term “residency” refers to distance or campus-based program.*

#### **Bachelor of Health Science**

*120 credits total including upper-level credits with a maximum diploma block transfer of 90 credits, of which 30 are upper-level credits. A GPA of 2.0 or higher is required for graduation.*

- Credits in first-year English (university-level or equivalent) if not granted as part of the block transfer from the diploma.
- 3 credits in introductory statistics
- 3 credits in humanities (other than English)
- 3 credits in social and behavioural research methods (upper-level)
- 6 credits in health issues (upper-level, taken though TRU-OL)

*Note: Students applying for admission to the degrees are required to provide original documentation showing their full post-secondary academic history along with graduation with a diploma in health care or related area from a recognized program and institution. Residency for this program is 15 credits. The term “residency” refers to distance or campus-based programs.*
